



THE CATTLEYARD - RUSHMERE FARM

Please do not try to follow your satnav as there is no access from Hambledon. Please use the directions provided. The Cattleyard is near Hambledon in Hampshire. For those coming from afar there are 3 main routes; from the A34, from the A3, and from the M27.

From the A34 – at Winchester take the A272(A31) exit from the roundabout. At the next roundabout continue straight on, and at the next roundabout turn left (East). Take the first left before the flyover (Morestead, Corhampton). Continue for 9 miles (15mins). Turn left (Corhampton, Meonstoke, Droxford). At the next roundabout continue straight on towards Droxford (A32). Take the next left, opposite garage (Denmead). Continue out of Hambledon, passed the Denmead village sign and take the first left. Follow this narrow road for a mile until a fork. Turn right at the fork, and then right past a corrugated old barn down pithill lane. After 200m you will see a wooden clad barn on your right. This is the Cattleyard.

From the A3 – Turn off at the Chalton/Clanfield/Butser Hill/Hambledon junction. Follow signs to Hambledon. Continue through Hambledon village, past the Vine pub on your right and turn left onto the B2150 take the first left. Continue out of Hambledon, passed the Denmead village sign and take the first left. Follow this narrow road for a mile until a fork Turn right at the fork, and then right past a corrugated old barn down pithill lane. After 200m you will see a wooden clad barn on your right. This is the Cattleyard.

From the M27 – Turn off at junction 11 and turn take exit off roundabout towards Boarhunt. Turn right at the T-junction (Boarhunt). Continue for 2 miles (5 mins) to cross-roads. Continue straight over towards Denmead. Continue (past World's End!) for 3.5 miles. At the T-junction turn sharply right towards Denmead. When you have passed the Denmead village sign, take the first left. Follow this narrow road for a mile until a fork Turn right at the fork, and then right past a corrugated old barn down pithill lane. After 200m you will see a wooden clad barn on your right. This is the Cattleyard.
